



Bilsdale Population Census 1841

The details in this booklet have been transcribed from the 1841 Population Census and it is pointed out that as the census enumerator did not enter family relationships these have been added to the transcript to aid identification. It is also pointed out that some of the ages listed by the enumerator have to be treated with caution as it has been found that when some are compared with baptisms in the parish registers there are several discrepancies.

Nevertheless this is the earliest record to give details of every man, woman and child living in Bilsdale on a particular day at the start of the fourth decade of the 19th century and the analysis of age groupings and occupations which can be found at the end of the transcripts provides a useful means of assessing the social and economic conditions in the dale.

The groupings of Bilsdale Kirkham, Bildale East and West Side and Laskill Pasture are those listed by the enumerator and it is pointed out that they differ from the groupings made in the census taken ten years later.

It can be seen that the financial well being of the community was almost totally dependent upon the state of farming as apart from the 743 farmers, labourers and their dependents who formed 79.4% of the population there were 54 assorted tradesmen whose livelihoods and those of their dependents would have also largely depended upon the custom they received from the local farming community. The three paupers would have been dependent upon relief provided by the Overseers of the Poor and as only the 18 people living on independent means and the soldier were not dependent on the farming economy it can be claimed that 97.9% of the people recorded in the 1841 Population Census of Bilsdale relied on farming to sustain their families' standards of living.
